Stone Family-200 (1819-2019)

Hobart-Tasmania

11th-13th October 2019

Day 1. (Friday 11th October 2019 10am @ Bagdad).

- Laying a plaque (200th year) near the unmarked Gravesites of Thomas & Ann.
- ⇒ Light Luncheon followed by a Stone Family Farm Visit



Day 2. (Saturday 12th October 2019)

- 1.5hour tours on the Lady Nelson 11am; 1pm; 3pm.
- Thomas & Ann arrived on the David Shaw after 4 months, having left Portsmouth on the 11th June 1819.
- (The Lady Nelson has been reserved for the Stone Family for Sat. 12th Oct.)
- ⇒ Buffet Meal 7-9pm—Venue to be announced (Possibly at Hobart Conference Centre where the Lady Nelson is moored)



Day 3. (Sunday 13th October 2019)

- 9:30am Service @ St John's Church.
14 St John's Avenue, NEW TOWN, TAS. 7008
- The Orphanage that Thomas & Ann 1831-1836 were in charge of is at the Church.
- ⇒ Visit the Millington's Cornelian Bay Cemetery site of Emma Hope (nee Stone) overlooking Cornelian Bay (Hobart). Ann was very heavily pregnant with Emma after 4 months at Sea.
